The Queensland Government has committed up to \$5.9 million over four annual rounds through the Queensland Remembers Grants Program to support the service and sacrifice of our veterans.

Round four is now open

Grants are available for ex-service and other not-for-profit organisations that directly provide support to Queensland veterans and their families.

- ✓ Major capital works grants program (between \$50,000 and \$250,000 ex. GST per grant) to deliver major capital works projects such as building refurbishments or upgrades, improving access for people with a disability or upgrading communal meeting areas.
- ✓ Minor capital works grants program (up to \$50,000 ex. GST per grant) to deliver minor capital works such as repairs to, or maintenance of, buildings or facilities, or for the purchase of equipment.
- ✓ Community grants program (up to \$50,000 ex. GST per grant) to deliver commemorative activities or events and projects such as the refurbishment and creation of memorials, avenues of honour and memorial gardens.
